All students are required to wear the school coat from Monday 2nd November. Hoodies may not be worn as part of the school uniform during the winter but are needed for P.E.

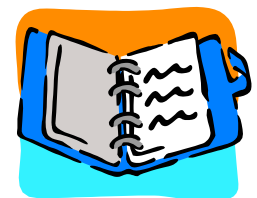
Exam Timetables
