The following email contains information regarding our 1:1 iPad Programme for **Transition Year 2025-2026.** 

Please find <u>attached the Resource and Booklist for Transition Year 2025-2026</u>. Few eBooks are used in TY, but other items are required.

This year we are introducing JAMF Safe Internet, mandatory for all students. This is a smart webfiltering tool for all year groups that ensures safe online learning at school and home, available via a one-off payment of €18.

As previously indicated, the <u>Support and Services charge to Wriggle for Senior Cycle (4th, 5th and 6th Year) is now built-in to the additional fees for Transition Year.</u> So, for the vast majority of TY students continuing to use the same iPad, there is no need to visit the Wriggle Online Store.

But, <u>if your daughter is a) new to the school, or b) needs to purchase a new iPad, you must visit the</u> Wriggle online store to purchase a new iPad (or avail of the BYO iPad option).

- Input our Store Login code 56147170, and then select the 4th Year store.

iPad is used extensively in TY, 5th and 6th Year as part of teaching and learning. Please ensure that your daughter has a fully working iPad configured for school use, and that any screen breaks are repaired over the summer. Additionally, please remind them to have a suitable protective case and iPad charger, and to back-up or delete any Junior Cycle material no longer required before the new academic year.
